THE STOCK BOY REPLIED, 'NO MA'AM, THEY'RE DEAD. . . '



Winchester Mystery House Reserved Car Club Parking



At the Winchester Mystery House, reserved parking is available to car clubs that intend to display their special vehicles. This parking is reserved for groups that will be arriving before noon on the day of their reservation. Sorry, parking spaces cannot be reserved later in the day. The reserved parking is located in the Winchester Mystery House Main Parking Lot in the row of spaces along Olsen Drive. There is room for up to 27 cars in that row. Please make your group's tour reservation at least 10 days in advance, then call with a final count of both people and cars at least 3 days in advance. We will reserve the appropriate number of spaces for your group's cars.

Upon arrival:

- Turn onto Olsen Drive.
- Turn left into the Winchester Mystery House Main Parking Lot driveway.
- The reserved spaces will be on your left upon entering the parking lot, marked with orange traffic cones.
- · Remove the cone in front of the space in which you intend to park.
- Most clubs prefer to back their cars into the spaces so that the fronts of the cars are facing out, visible to our other guests.

If more than the expected number of cars arrive with your group and there are not enough spaces reserved, feel free to use any other open spaces for the remaining vehicles in your group.

Please note that while our staff attempts to patrol the parking lot on a semiregular basis, Winchester Mystery House is not liable for any damage, vandalism, or theft of your vehicle that occurs while it is parked in the lot.
